

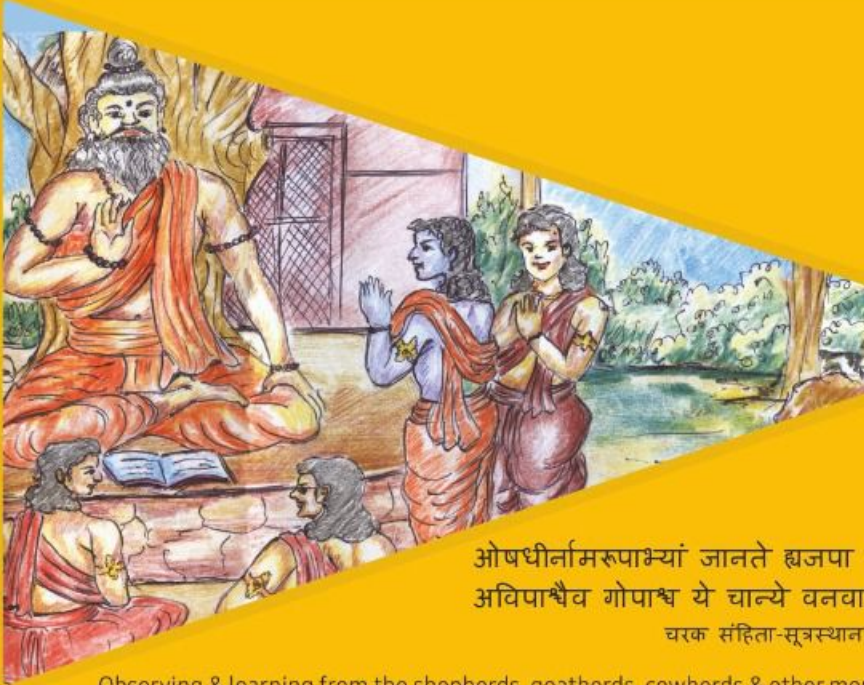

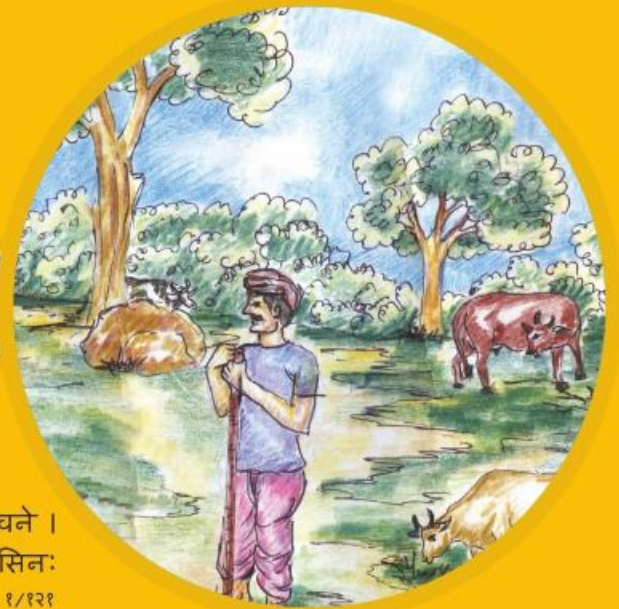

- Title in **capital bold of 24 font size**, followed by authors name, affiliation, postal address & email id of corresponding author.
- Narration in **IMRD** pattern (Introduction, methods, results, discussion).

Word limit	Font	Size	Line Spacing
200 words	Times New Roman	10 point	1.15

- Abstracts should be sent to email : sdmseminar2020@gmail.com before 10th January.
- Corresponding author will be notified of its acceptance for either oral or e-poster presentation after the scrutiny by scientific committee through mail.
- Presenting author should submit the finalized power point for oral presentation within 10 days of receiving acceptance letter. Full papers which depict the objectivity and the applicability of the theme of the seminar will be given priority.
- **Duration of oral presentation will be 4+1 min.**
- In e-poster, all diagrams, pictures, tables and equations should be visible and readable.
- Best paper/ Poster will be recognized and awarded.
- Souvenir will be released on the second day of International congress.

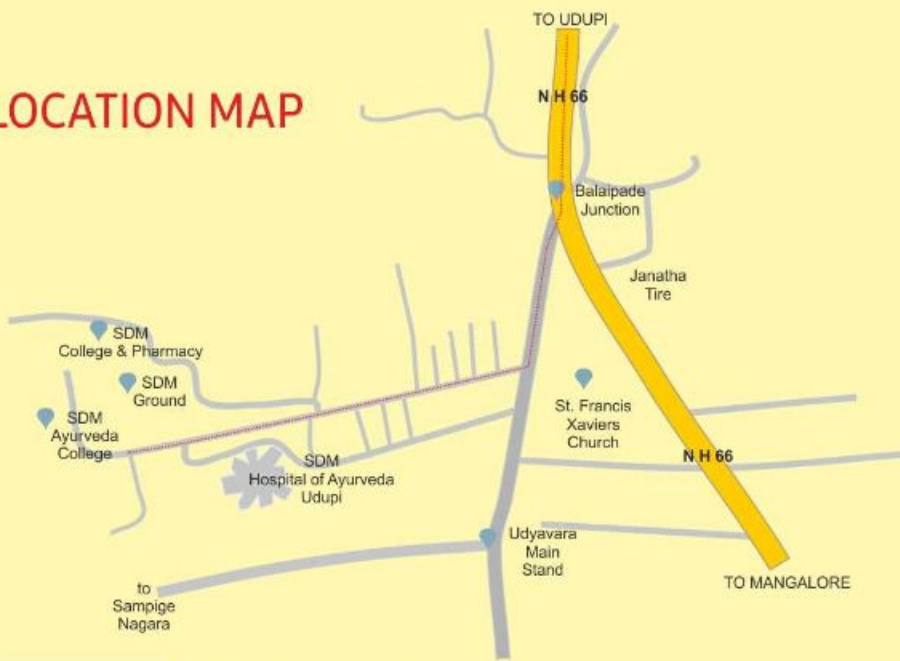

BY FLIGHT : Nearest airport is Bajpe airport, Mangalore, Karnataka 48 KM away from Udupi.

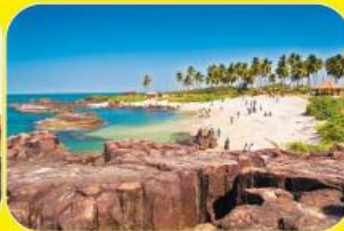
BY TRAIN : There are regular trains to Udupi Railway Station from other major cities of the country.
